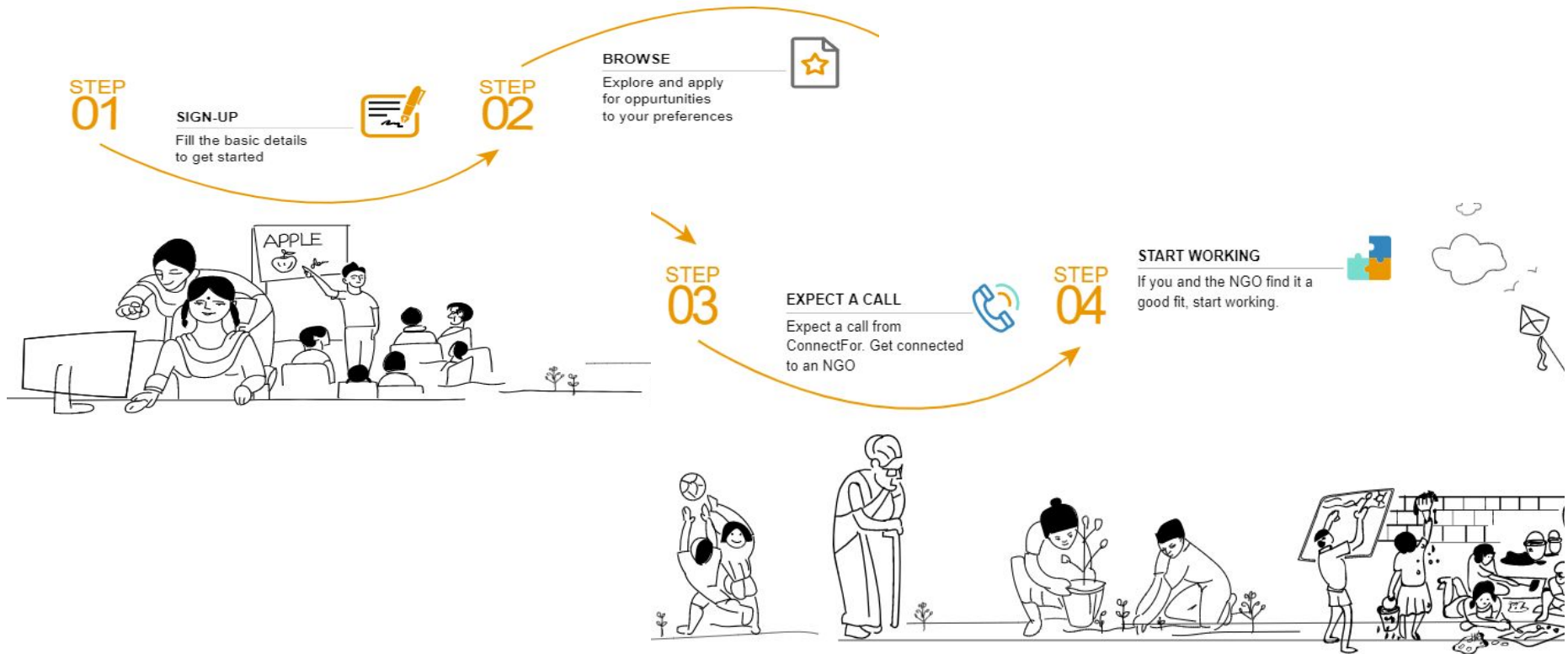

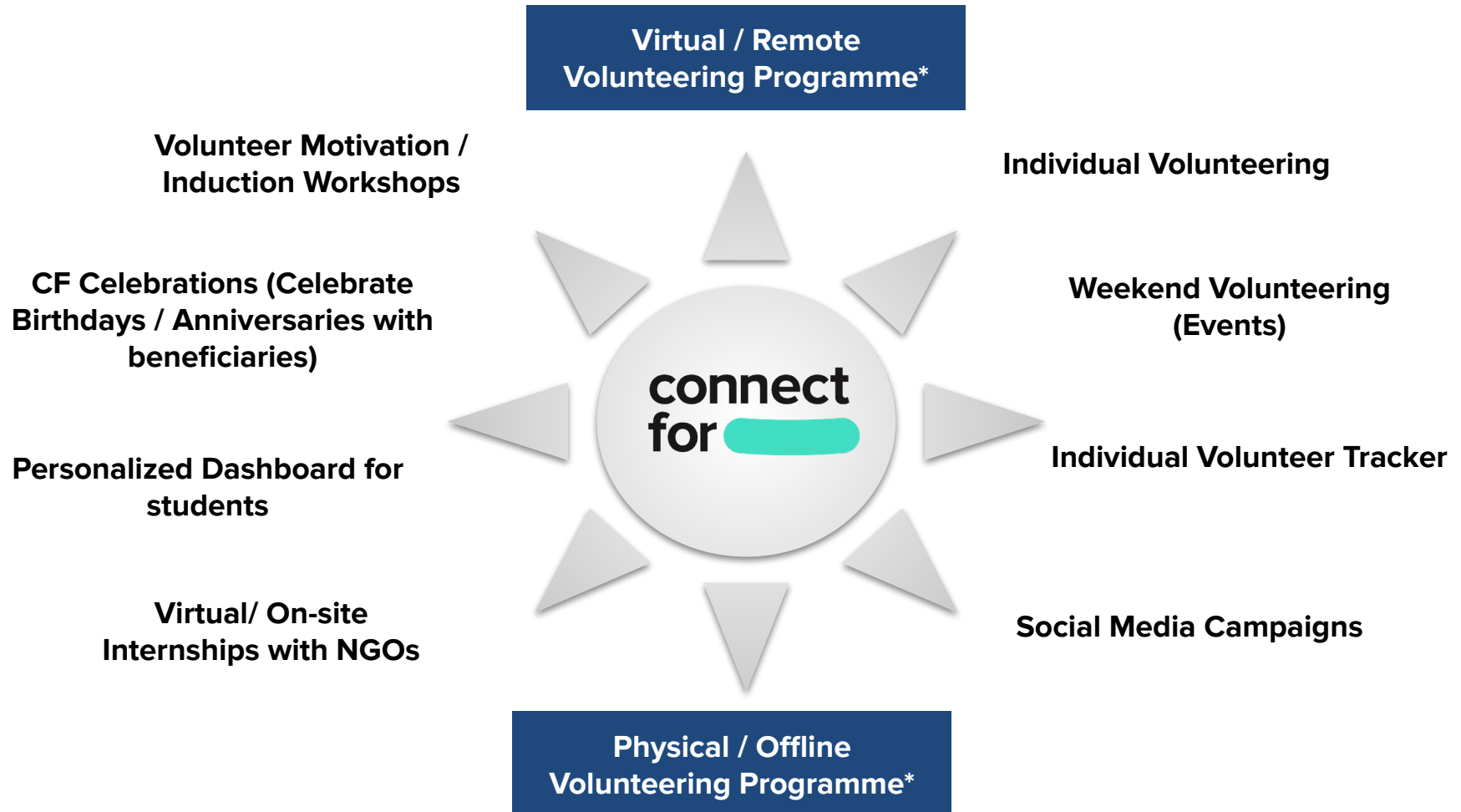
# HOW CONNECTFOR WORKS?

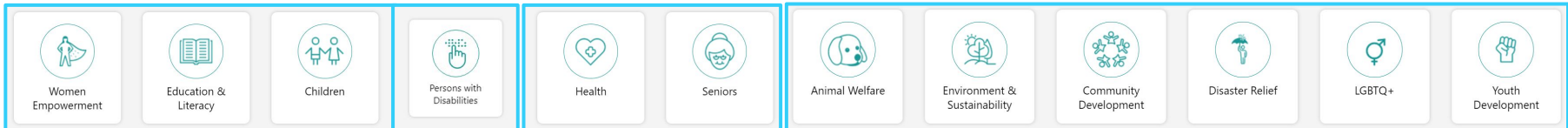

# 4 STEPS TO VOLUNTEERING INTERNSHIP VIA CONNECTFOR

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## Step 1

### **Registration Process: Starting Your Volunteering Journey**

By registering on our website, [www.connectfor.org](http://www.connectfor.org) the volunteers can have access to 1000+ opportunities for them to choose from based on their skill set. ConnectFor will also assist by identifying the best match and connecting the volunteer to the NGO.

## Step 2

### **Connection Process: Availing Volunteering Opportunities**

ConnectFor will reach out to the registered volunteers on call to understand their preferences, skills, and time commitments and connect them to the NGO via email. ConnectFor can also organize a mixer with volunteers' and NGOs, which will help facilitate a conversation with the NGOs that they will be connected to.

## Step 3

### **Management Process: Monitoring Your Volunteering Lifecycle**

ConnectFor will do fortnightly follow-ups with NGOs to track the progress of the individual volunteers. We will also monitor the progress of this collaboration on a weekly/monthly basis until project completion based on the nature of the collaboration. A shared sheet will to be created, where the group can update the details accordingly. This will help analyse and track the progress of the collaboration between both the stakeholders.

## Step 4

### **Project Completion: Recognition For Your Contributions**

ConnectFor will provide certificates to all the volunteers upon completion of the project/volunteering task assigned.

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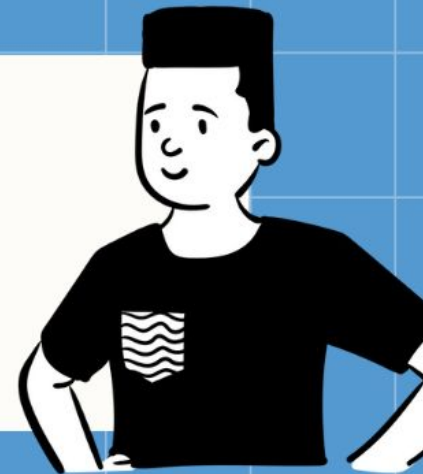


## Dipika Fulzele

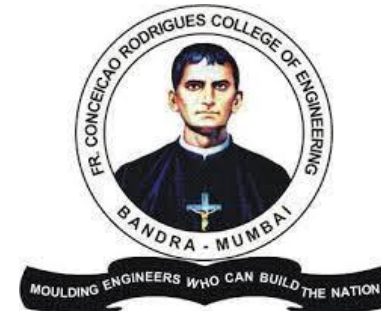
