It is hereby notified that the elections of the Office Bearers of the college Students' Union and Central Councillors will be held on Thursday, 18th September, 2025 as per details and schedule given below: -


COLLEGE STUDENTS' UNION POSTS

1. PRESIDENT	: ONE POST
2. VICE- PRESIDENT	: ONE POST
3. SECRETARY	: ONE POST
4. JOINT SECRETARY	: ONE POST
5. CENTRAL COUNCILLORS	: TWO POST

Provided that:

- a) The President should be 3rd & 4th Year student.
- b) The Vice-President and the Joint Secretary should not be 4th year student.
- c) Be between age of 17 and 22 years as on August 16th, 2025.
- d) Have attained 75% attendance.
- e) The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election. Any pending paper(s) will be construed as academic arrear(s). Candidates failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current academic year will not be eligible to contest the election.
- f) The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of executive member. No candidate can contest simultaneously for more than one post.
- g) Not have a previous criminal record, must not have been convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanour. The student shall also not have been subjected to any disciplinary action.
- h) Abide by the code of conduct, as per the Supreme Court Judgment.
- i) Every candidate is required to furnish an affidavit on Rs.10/- Stamp Paper, along with the Security Deposit of Rs.500/-, to the effect:
 - i) That he/she does not have any previous criminal record and has not been subjected to any disciplinary action by the University/College.
 - ii) That I have not failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current year.
- k) The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be Rs. 5000/-.
- l) Each candidate shall, within two weeks of the declaration of the result submit complete and audited accounts to the College/University authorities.
- m) Canvassing time for the DUSU Elections from 03:00 P.M. to 07:00 P.M. Each candidate will have not more than 04 (four) bonafide students while canvassing in the College/Campus.
- n) As per the University's directives, the following requirements in addition to the above are mandatory for Students contesting the elections:-

- i). A Surety bond on a Rs.100/- Judicial Stamp Paper, to be executed by the parent /guardian of the contesting Student.
- ii). The Surety bond shall also bear the signatures of two witnesses.
- iii). An affidavit on a Rs.100/- Stamp Paper duly attested and notarized to be submitted by the contesting student.
- iv). In case a Student files nomination for two or more posts, separate Surety bonds and affidavits shall be submitted for each post.


