This is to inform all students that as part of the academic curriculum, a **Dissertation** must be undertaken during the 7th Semester under the guidance of an assigned supervisor.

**Objectives & Outcomes**

Each student is expected to accomplish the following **four outcomes** by the end of the semester:

- i. **Research Problem Identification**
- ii. **Review of Literature**
- iii. **Research Design Formulation**
- iv. **Commencement of Experimentation, Fieldwork, or Similar Tasks**
