The LokFolk Cultural Society of Motilal Nehru College Evening (MLNCE), University of Delhi, continued its vibrant and dynamic journey during the academic session 2025–2026. The society sustained excellence across its core cultural domains—dance, music, and art—while consistently fostering creativity, collaboration, and cultural awareness among its members.

A major highlight of the session was LokFolk's participation in the international conference "Seema Vimarsh" held on 22 August 2025. The society also actively contributed to institutional celebrations such as the Diwali Mela (October 2025), and continued to organise workshops and practice sessions to refine artistic skills. In the second half of the academic year, the society delivered impactful performances at Saraswati Pooja (23 January 2026), Delhi University Literature Festival (12, 13 and 14 February 2026), Vasantotsav, and Freshers' events.
